

Age:6-7

The unwavering Oscar strives towards the novel, the unexplored, and the strange.

He's tall and thin. Oscar doesn't like to be lectured, and instead lectures others. He's always ready for adventure, and despite his apparent whimsy, is reliable and always ready to help.



## Adam Bunny

#### Age: **5**

Adam is shy, calm, even-tempered, very responsible, and easy-going. He's a little on the chubby side.



Archibald Fox



Age: **6-7** 

Archibald and Oscar are the same age. He is the antagonist.

Inventive, cunning, but a typical underdog. Archibald is an adventurer – a Robin Hood of sorts. Deep in his heart, he wants to live in peace with all the inhabitants of the surrounding area and the castle itself, but – he finds this kind of life extremely boring. The risk-taking nature of this adventurer takes over, and Archibald once again finds his way onto the malevolent, yet entertaining path of practical jokes and pranks. However, each time he concocts a mischievous plan, in the end, he usually becomes the butt of the joke, yet he always reacts as though it could have been worse.

Archibald has three faithful "minions", three Vole mice, who are his fellow adventurers – always ready to carry out any of his orders.









### Vole Trio

#### Age:3-4

Always scampering around, the nimble little gadabouts. They annoy all the inhabitants of the castle and the surrounding area with their tricks. The Voles are petty thieves, pranksters and hooligans. They constantly squabble, argue, bicker, and quarrel with one another, but they are quick to make up.

Their behavior is similar to extravagant, tireless, and mischievous minions.

They are very curious and reckless, even when in the face of something very scary, they overcome their fears and "plunge" into the most incredible situations. The members of Vole Trio frequently encourage each other, giggling and provoking mischievous actions, and rush headfirst into any adventure that comes their way.

The Voles are selflessly devoted to Archibald Fox, ready to serve their leader in anything he asks.



### Grandfather's Portrait



An important character in our story.

He is the keeper of ancient secrets and serves as an archive of wisdom.

Grandfather is laconic and ironic, patient and restrained, while at the same time very charming.

He watches over and guides our main characters in difficult situations. His help is not direct, but rather allegorical, as he gives Oscar, Adam and Mary brainteasers and hints that they have to solve.

Grandfather's Portrait often talks in rhyme. He helps without being too preachy,

and knows how to crack a good joke or two.

by a bridge to the mainland.










